- SUPPORTS BASED ON INDIVIDUAL NEEDS DURING HOURS WHEN PRE PANDEMIC WOULD HAVE BEEN PARTICIPATING IN OTHER ACTIVITIES
- FOLLOWING GUIDANCE FOR SOCIAL DISTANCING

- COVID CASES DECLINING
- MORE PEOPLE BEING VACCINATED
- OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES PRIORITIZED
- HOW TO SERVE PEOPLE SAFELY
- HOW TO TRANSPORT
- WHAT TYPE OF SOCIAL DISTANCING CAN BE PRACTICED
- PERSON CENTER PLANS
- IMPORTANT TO CONSIDER WHAT SERVICES WILL LOOK LIKE GOING FORWARD

TRANSPORTATION

- WHAT HAVE WE DONE TO PREPARE
- REQUEST SAFETY PLAN FROM TRANSPORTATION CONTRACTED VENDORS PRIOR TO STARTING IN-PERSON SERVICES
- COMMUNICATE WITH PARATRANSIT SYSTEMS OF DAY PROGRAMS THAT WILL START IN-PERSON SERVICES
- CONTINUE TO CHECK IN ON CDC GUIDELINES FOR RIDESHARE SERVICES
- NOTIFY DAY PROGRAMS OF POTENTIAL DELAYS DUE TO SOCIAL DISTANCING REQUIREMENT WITHIN VEHICLE
- REQUEST DAY PROGRAMS VENDORED FOR TRANSPORTATION AS AN ADDITIONAL COMPONENT TO ACKNOWLEDGE CDC GUIDELINES FOR RIDESHARE SERVICES WHEN SUBMITTING PLAN TO RESUME IN-PERSON SERVICES
- REQUEST SCHEDULE FROM DAY PROGRAMS WITH CONTRACTED TRANSPORTATION VENDOR ROUTE TO CONFIRM ESTIMATED TIMES OF ARRIVAL DUE TO SOCIAL DISTANCING

DAY PROGRAMS

- LICENSED/SITE BASED: EXPECTED TO FOLLOW LOCAL COUNTY/CDC GUIDANCE, CHECK IN WITH COMMUNITY CARE LICENSING (CCL) PRIOR TO OPENING. ALAMEDA AND CONTRA COSTA COUNTIES ARE NOT REQUIRING THAT ADULT DAY PROGRAMS CHECK IN PRIOR TO RESUMING IN PERSON SERVICES.
- REQUEST SAFETY PLAN FROM SERVICE PROVIDERS PRIOR TO RESUMING IN PERSON SERVICES.
- CCL PROVIDER INFORMATION NOTICE: PROGRAMS CANNOT SAY NO TO SERVING AN INDIVIDUAL FOR IN PERSON SERVICES IF THAT PERSON HAS NOT BEEN VACCINATED.
- SERVICE PROVIDERS CANNOT SHARE INFORMATION ABOUT PARTICIPANTS' VACCINE STATUS WITH OTHERS DUE TO HIPAA.
- HYBRID SCHEDULES: DAY PROGRAMS ARE OFFERING STAGGERED DAYS TO REDUCE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS AT PROGRAM ON ONE DAY.
- ALTERNATIVES ON DAYS NOT OPENED: THE OTHER DAYS INDIVIDUALS MAY BE OFFERED ALTERNATIVE SERVICES SUCH AS ZOOM CLASSES.

COMMUNITY BASED PROGRAMS

- PLANNING FOR OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES
- FRESH AIR BALANCED WITH SMALL CONSISTENT GROUPS
- EXPECTED TO FOLLOW LOCAL COUNTY/CDC GUIDELINES

DDS DIRECTIVE FOR IN PERSON VISITS BY RCEB TO INDIVIDUALS LIVING IN LICENSED SETTINGS, FHS, ILS, SLS

- QUALITY ASSURANCE STAFF
- CASE MANAGERS
- WILL LIMIT THE TIME FOR VISITS INDOORS TO 15 MINUTES AND WILL FOLLOW PUBLIC HEALTH GUIDANCE
- CURRENTLY BASED ON DDS DIRECTIVES, INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES IN HOME SETTINGS CAN REQUEST REMOTE VISITS TO CONTINUE



SUPPORTS FOR ADULTS LIVING AT HOME

- HYBRID PROGRAMS
- CAN CONTINUE TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL SUPPORT INCLUDING DAY CARE WHEN PEOPLE ARE NOT ATTENDING PROGRAMS AND FAMILIES WORKING



SCHOOL RE OPENINGS

- ANTICIPATE MOST SCHOOLS WILL REOPEN FOR THE FALL SEMESTER

FULL TIME INSTRUCTION IS EXPECTED IN MOST DISTRICTS

- RCEB WILL SUPPORT CHILDCARE AND OTHER SUPPORTS FOR BOTH CHILDREN ON HYBRID SCHEDULES AND THOSE WHO HAVEN'T RETURNED TO SCHOOL THROUGH THE SUMMER
- CASE MANAGERS WILL MEET WITH THE ID TEAM TO DISCUSS SUPPORTS FOR THE FALL AS SCHOOLS AND WORK PLACES REOPEN
