

RCEB IS RECRUITING FOR BOARD MEMBERS!

Board members play an important role in providing policy leadership and oversight for RCEB. The Lanterman Act requires that the Board reflect the geographic and ethnic characteristics of our area as well as the various categories of disability that we serve. The Board must also have persons with legal, management, financial, public relations and developmental disability program skills. No less than 25% of the board must be self-advocates (persons with developmental disabilities) and a minimum of 50% of the Board must be persons with developmental disabilities or their parents/legal guardians.

- Self -Advocates
