These funds will allow our vendors to provide wage, salary and benefit increases to direct care staff and will go into effect July 1st.</p>

Presentation</p>	<p>The Concord office will start moving to its new location (1320 Willow Pass Rd.) on May 20th with a completion date by May 23rd.</p> <p>Due to organizational issues, the contract for Asian Community Mental Health Services has been discontinued, effective June 30, 2016.
