NEW SERVICES UPDATES

Sandra Coss

- . EBSDD and Sister Marygrace hosted 4 Spanish speaking support groups. Eight mothers participated.
- . Mothers need extra support because they are at the center of the family. The support sustains their resiliency.
- . Attendance to support groups depends on various reasons.
- . Providers must develop patience to deal with attendance inconsistencies.

Anna Wang

- . At FCSN we provide childcare when parents attend seminars. After each seminar, families eat dinner together.
- . FCSN continues to provide mentorship to families. These services are essential for families.
- . Rates must change to make services possible.

DIVERSITY & EQUITY SPECIALIST SUMMARY – Jairo Guiza
