The AFIRM modules that have been created by CAPTAIN. Our hope is to promote these modules within our homes and day programs. The modules are all based on evidence-based practices like prompting, reinforcement, self-management, task analysis, etc. Each module is about 1.5 – 2 hours long, has a pre- and post-test, and you can choose to earn a certificate for passing the module.

They have two online courses on IDD and sexuality: The "Developmental Disability and Sexuality 101" course has 6 modules, each about 90 min long. Each module has a handout that must be filled out to show participating and objectives learned.

The "Talking with Your Kids: Developmental Disability and Sexuality" course has the same layout as the above course but its target audience is parents. This portion for children group homes only.

PCT Trainings

All trainings will be held from 10AM-1PM Virtually
August 23rd, 24th, 25th, 30th and September 1st.

Person-Centered Thinking revolves around the core principle of balancing What's Important To someone and What's Important For someone. Through this training, attendees will learn practical skills that they can take back to their respective workplaces that center the person being supported, while continuing to effectively improve the supports that are currently in place.

NOTE: As this training has been moved to a virtual space, attendees can expect to invest about 18 hours of training delivered via Zoom. Each training series will consist of 6 dates and times and attendees are expected to attend **ALL** parts of the series to receive their credit. Moreover, we are also requesting **one person per computer screen with a webcam and microphone**, as you are able, since this is a highly interactive training with breakout groups throughout the training. Finally, more training series will be released as we continually assess the impact of COVID-19 on PCT training offerings.

New! Supporting ID/DD Sexual Offenders

Thursday, September 29, 2022, 9am - 3pm, Virtually*

This training aims to help attendees gain basic knowledge of sexual behavior in adults with intellectual/developmental disabilities and receive practical strategies in decreasing challenging sexual behavior. This webinar will also focus on preventative strategies to minimize the risk of our consumers engaging in harmful sexual behaviors through teaching consent and functional skills training. Attendees will receive current research and statistics regarding sexual behavior in consumers, training in Applied Behavior Analysis, and learn practical techniques that can be applied to their respective workplaces. **6 hours ARM credits:**

New! Teaching Communication to Reduce Challenging Behaviors

Functional Communication Training (FCT) is an evidence-based practice that replaces challenging behaviors with more appropriate and effective communication. This training provides information about how to determine why challenging behavior is happening, how to select a more appropriate communication behavior, and how to effectively teach this new behavior. **3 Hours ARM credits**
